PORTFOLIO DESCRIPTION

The US Index BRI portfolio invests in shares of a broadly diversified group of US and foreign companies which meet our comprehensive BRI screening criteria. The portfolio is designed to closely match the returns of major US equity market indices.

BIBLICALLY RESPONSIBLE INVESTING (BRI)

Christian investors naturally want to be good stewards of the wealth the Lord has entrusted to them. For this reason, they are concerned about how their investments line up with their beliefs and convictions. 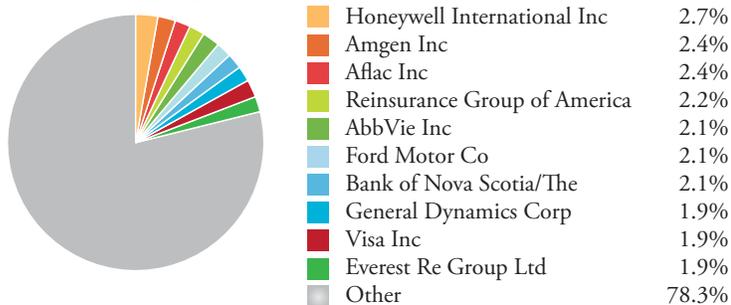
INVESTMENT APPROACH

PORTFOLIO CONSTRUCTION

The US Index BRI portfolio is constructed using a proprietary quantitative process. After defining an initial universe of US-traded stocks, companies with BRI violations are excluded. Using a multifactor risk model, a portfolio of stocks is optimized to minimize active risk relative to the US equity market.

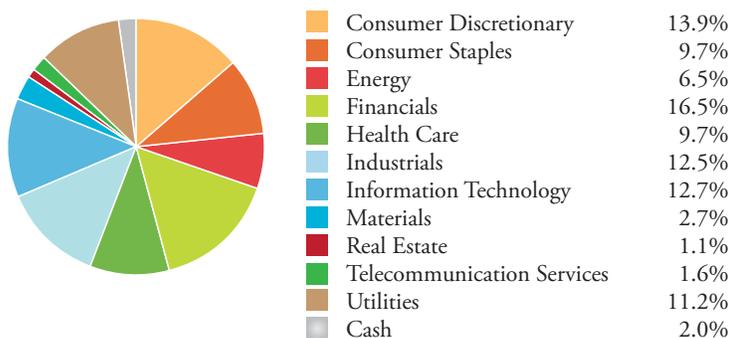
Top 10 Holdings
